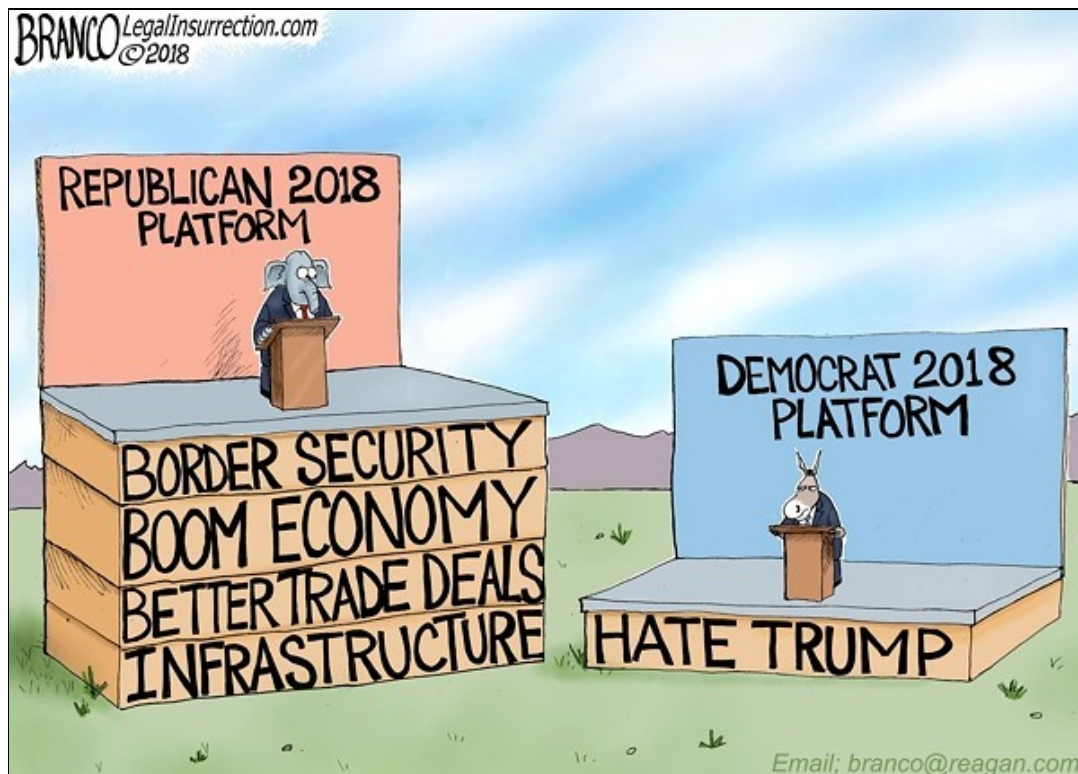

The 2019 KRP Year Thus Far

The year 2019 has been a very busy year thus far. We started the year with a Political Conservative Comedian, Eric Golub from Los Angeles, CA. Eric performed a great political stand-up comedy routine on the last Saturday of January, the 26th. The event was held at 6 PM in the evening at the Lihue Missionary Church in Lihue. We enjoyed pupus, light refreshments and each other's fellowship. There was a turn-out of over 30 people.

On Saturday February 9th we held our annual Precinct Elections electing officers and delegates in each of the three districts of Kauai. The three district chairs elected to office were: HD14 David R. Hamman, HD15 Villamor Galiza and HD16 Fred Sarmento. Further activity followed finding those who volunteered to be delegates and alternates for the upcoming county and state conventions. The KRP was able to fill all 67 delegate seats, the first time this has been done that I know of.

On Saturday, March 23rd the KRP County Convention convened at the Lihue Missionary Church to elect the 2019-2021 KRP Officers. Those elected were Steve Yoder, County Chair, Bob Bradford, first Vice Chair, Marilyn Bradford, 2nd Vice Chair, Sandi Sterker, 3rd Vice Chair, Nina Magoun, 4th Vice Chair, Secretary, LaVerne Bessert and Treasurer, Jennie Beck. In April Walter Casey was elected precinct chair of 14-3 (Moloaa/Anahola/Kealia) and Bryce Boeder was elected precinct chair of 16-4 (Waimea).

On Saturday, May 11th, the HRP State Convention convened on Maui with over 200 in attendance. The KRP brought 22 delegates to the Maui state convention. Those elected to office at the state convention were Shirlene Ostrov, State Chair, Vice Chairs: Al Frenzel, Coordinating Campaigns; Ray L'Heureux, Communications; Steve Lipscomb, Community Service and Rojo Herrera, Coalitions; Ka'eo Kealoha-Lindsey, Secretary; Marilyn Moniz-Kahoohanhano, Treasurer.

Please support those who were elected to office so we can build the Kauai Republican Party and elect Kauai Republicans to political office.
